



CURLING LEAGUES - 2017-2018

MONDAY

Golden Rockers – 10:00 – 12:00 (also plays Fri a.m.)

- Open to all curlers; Focus is having fun
- Ideal for new Day Curlers
- Teams are made up prior to start of each game
- Rules are based on a point system

Evening – Social – 2 draws – 19:00 & 20:30 (Full Year)

- Open to all curlers
- Social league designed to mix all levels of players
- Match assigned teams
- Different teams set for first and second halves of the season to maximize social interaction
- Games 8 Ends if one draw, 6 Ends if 2 draws

TUESDAY

Windmill – 10:00 (November to December) – Most Competitive Day League

- Skip's Choice (All Men OR All Women Teams)
- Open to All Curlers. Enter a team of 4. A team may include a fifth player (to act as an alternate)
- All Games 8 Ends

Pratt – 10:00 (January to February)

- Skip's Choice - Lead Assigned (Mixed Team Allowed)
- Maximum 10 points teams, as rated
- Open to All Curlers. Enter a team of 3 or sign up individually
- Match will assign Lead to each team
- All Games 8 Ends

Jubilee – 10:00 (February to April)

- Skip's Choice - Lead Assigned (Mixed Teams Allowed)
- Maximum 10 points teams, as rated
- Open to All Curlers. Enter a team of 3 or sign up individually
- Match will assign Lead to each team
- All Games 8 Ends

Evening – True Mixed Competitive – 19:30

- Teams must be composed of man, woman, man, woman or vice-versa
- The 5th player can replace any member / position on the team
- If a spare is used, the spare has to be of the same gender and position as the player needing the spare
- If only 3 people composed the team, the line up is man, woman, man, etc.

WEDNESDAY

Mixed Match Drawn League – 10:00 (Two sessions)

- Open to All Curlers
- All Games are 8 ends
- Match assigned teams

Evening – Pre-Competitive – 19:30

- Skip's Choice - Lead assigned (Skip may choose his 3rd and 2nd but lead will be assigned—does not matter the gender or experience)
- Team total rating must not be over 10
- Points are accumulated based on wins and ties in each match and a league champion declared at the end of the 1st and 2nd half (Bradshaw and Rankin trophies)

THURSDAY

Doubles League – 13:00 (Two Sessions)

- Open to All Curlers
- All Games are 6 ends
- Match Assigned Teams
- No sweeping between hog lines
- Free Guard Zone NOT in effect

Evening – Competitive – 19:30

- Skip's Choice
- Ladder format
- Men-only or Women-only teams
- Spare can be of any gender





FRIDAY

Golden Rockers – 10:00 - 12:00 (also plays Mon a.m.)

- Open to all curlers; Focus is having fun
- Ideal for new Day Curlers
- Teams are made up prior to start of each game
- Rules are based on a point system

Evening – Social - 2 draws - 19:00 & 21:00 (Full Year)

- Open to all curlers
- Social league designed to mix all levels of players
- Match assigned teams
- Different teams set for first and second halves of the season to maximize social interaction
- All Games 8 Ends

SATURDAY

Regular Doubles (TOMMY HUNTER) – Two sessions in the morning

- For teams rated 5 points or less
- 6 end games
- Alternate skip after 4 rocks
- No sweeping between the Hog lines
- Handicap rule: before the start of each game, the rating difference between the teams (for 6 end games only) is MULTIPLIED by 1 ½ and added to the score of the lower rated team
- The team giving up points will have the hammer for the first end. Equally rated teams will spin for the hammer

Olympic Doubles

If you are both experienced curlers and would like to hone your skills, Olympic Doubles is for you.

- Teams with a 5.5 rating or higher
- 8 ends are played and only 6 rocks are played for each team. One rock from each team is placed strategically at the beginning of each end and the remaining 5 are thrown from each team
- Sweeping is allowed by both players between the hog lines
- One player throws the first and last rock while the other throws the middle 3
- No rock can be hit out of play until the 4th rock is thrown

Challenge your skills and your strategic mind with this exciting new game. A computer display will be available during sign up.

SUNDAY

Social league

- Designed to mix all levels of players
- Open to all curlers
- Match assigned teams
- Different teams set for first and second halves of the season to maximize social interaction
- All Games 8 Ends

TUESDAY | THURSDAY | FRIDAY

“3 O’Clock Pickup” League

- Tuesdays, Thursdays & Fridays from 15:00 – 17:00
- Men & women; All skill levels
- Focus is on fun and everyone trying new positions if they want
- 6 ends is the norm
- No need to confirm participation... just show up if you want to play!

INTERCLUB LEAGUE

- The Master’s Interclub League (MICL) comprises 13 Montreal area curling clubs.
- Skip’s Choice
- Curlers must be 50+ years of age
- Each club plays against each other club twice in a season – one match at “home” and the other “away” at the other club
- Games are usually played on Thursday or Friday morning
- Points are accumulated based on wins and ties in each match and a league champion declared at season end

The format for each match:

- 9:30 – Teams arrive at host club and enjoy coffee with rum and Tim-Bits
- 10:00 – Teams play 8 end games
- 12:00 – Teams socialize in typical post game fashion
- 12:30 approx. – Lunch provided





SENIOR CASHSPIEL LEAGUE

- The Senior Cashspiel League comprises over 40 clubs in Eastern Ontario and Western Quebec.
- Curlers must be 50+ years of age
- Each club hosts 1-3 cashspiels during the season
- There are typically 1-3 games available every week during the season
- Teams contribute \$100 per team (\$20 of which goes to a 50/50 draw) and play one game
- First, second and third place teams are determined by wins and draw to the button scores
- We would like 3 teams to participate with each team expected to play roughly 10 times during the season
- Lunch is included
