



CURLING LEAGUES - 2021-2022

MONDAY

Golden Rockers – 10:00 - 12:00 (also plays Mon a.m.)

- Drop in Curling. Teams are made up from those in attendance at 09:45.
- No need to commit for any date
- All curlers of any are welcome.
- Ideal for Day Curlers new to curling, new to Whitlock, joined mid-season, or are waiting for a spot on a team.
- New teams are made each day with a goal that everybody has a good outing.
- Individual performance is tracked with points system for attendance, wins, and a daily draw to the button.

Evening – Social

- 2 draws (19:00 – 20:30, 20:30 – 22:00)
- If insufficient registered, 1 draw – 19:30
- Open to all curlers
- Social league designed to mix all skill levels of players
- Match assigned teams
- Different teams set for first and second halves of the season to maximize social interaction
- Games 6 Ends
- Possibility of 3-person teams

TUESDAY

Windmill Competitive – 10:00

- Most Competitive Day League
- Ladder format – year long
- Skip's Choice
- Open to All Curlers.
Enter a team of 4. A team may include a fifth player (to act as an alternate)

Dreamers

- 13:30 Start
- Open to all curlers at all levels
- Designed as a fun learning game (weekly sign up via email or online).
- Players alternate positions at each end from First to Skip
- New teams each week. Depending on number of curlers could be set up in teams of 2, 3 or 4
- Games 6 Ends

Evening – True Mixed Competitive

- 2 draws – 19:00 and 21:00
- Teams must be composed of man, woman, man, woman or vice-versa
- The 5th player can only replace a member of the same gender on the team.
- If a spare is used, the spare has to be of the same gender and position as the player needing the spare
- If only 3 people composed the team, the line up is man/woman/man or women/man/women
- Ladder format

WEDNESDAY

Mixed Match Drawn League – 10:00

- Two sessions (Fall and Winter)
- Open to All Curlers
- Match assigned teams

The 'Sticklers' *NEW LEAGUE* - 13:00

This league is new and is based on the stick doubles concept. Fun game for experienced or inexperienced stick curlers. Each team of 2 curlers

- Stick mandatory
- No sweeping between hog lines
- New partner each game
- Six stones per end
- 6 end games

- 2 draws – 19:00 and 21:00
- If insufficient registered, 1 draw – 19:30
- Skip's choice
- Ladder format





THURSDAY

Interclub League

The Master's Interclub League (MICL) comprises 13 Montreal area curling clubs.

- Games are usually played on Thursday or Friday morning
- Skip's Choice
- Curlers must be 50+ years of age
- Each club plays against each other club twice in a season – one match at “home” and the other “away” at the other club
- Points are accumulated based on wins and ties in each match and a league champion declared at season end

Doubles League

- 13:00 and 15:00
- Open to All Curlers
- All Games are 6 ends
- Match assigned teams - if necessary
- Free Guard Zone not in effect
- Sweeping allowed between hog lines (one sweeper only)

Evening – Competitive

- 2 draws – 19:00 and 21:00
- Skip's choice
- Ladder format
- Gender neutral (Mixed, Men-only or Women-only) teams
- Spare can be of any gender

FRIDAY

SATURDAY

Regular Doubles (TOMMY HUNTER)

- Start Times will alternate weekly between 10:30 and Noon
- 6 end games
- Alternate skip after 4 rocks
- Sweeping is allowed

Olympic Doubles

If you are both experienced curlers and would like to hone your skills, Olympic Doubles is for you. Number and timing of draws to be determined by participation.

- Start Times will alternate weekly between 10:30 and Noon
- 8 ends are played and only 6 rocks are played for each team. One rock from each team is placed strategically at the beginning of each end and the remaining 5 are thrown from each team
- Sweeping is allowed by both players between the hog lines
- One player throws the first and last rock while the other throws the middle 3
- No rock can be hit out of play until the 4th rock is thrown
